Pursuant to the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.(C) No. 75/2012 titled BACHPAN BACHAO ANDOLON vs. UNION OF INDIA & Ors. and in terms of the letter No. L/39/2012-NALSA-1097 dated 23.05.2013 of the NALSA conveyed through letter no. 1718(19)/SLSA-60/10 dated 29.07.13 read with earlier letter no. 1611(19)/SLSA-60/2012 dated 12.07.2013 and the latest guideline & model scheme provided in 1278(19)/SLSA-60/2010 Dtd. 19.05.2014 by the State Legal Services Authority, West Bengal regarding deployment of Para- Legal Volunteers (here-in- after referred to as PLVs in short), in shifts, in the police station to keep watch over the manner in which the complaints regarding missing and other offences against children, are dealt with, I, after the publication of new panel of PLVs following the scheme for PLV (Revised) and module for Orientation-Induction-Refreshers Courses as norms and criterions fixed by Selection Committee, 2014, hereby select and nominate till further order the following PLVs, in the following scheme and format to do so P.S. wise as noted against their name from the date of this order. Accordingly, following the revised scheme & guidelines, DLSA, Malda is hereby temporarily appointing the following PLVs, against each P.S., whereby there will be deputation of 2 (two) PLVs and each of them shall visit once a week to their respective allotted P.S – first PLV shall visit in the first half of the week (preferably on each Thursday) and the the second PLV in the later half of the week (preferably on each Sunday) and as such there shall be total two visits in each week by the PLVs with a rider that either of them shall make his or her services available on a special call by the respective P.S. on any other day of the week.

The PLVs shall report to the P.S. concerned after receipt of this order and maintain a diary for performance of their work and submit report of the work entrusted to the office of DLSA, Malda every fortnight on the specific format already provided to them and ensure GDE at the time of entry as well as exit from the respective P.S. entrusted against their name.

The PLVs are further directed to report this authority in case of any difficulty in performing their entrusted duty, over telephone, during office hours (Tel. no. 256803).

Each of the PLVs will get honorarium @ Rs. 250/- per day of attendance, which includes travelling expenses.
